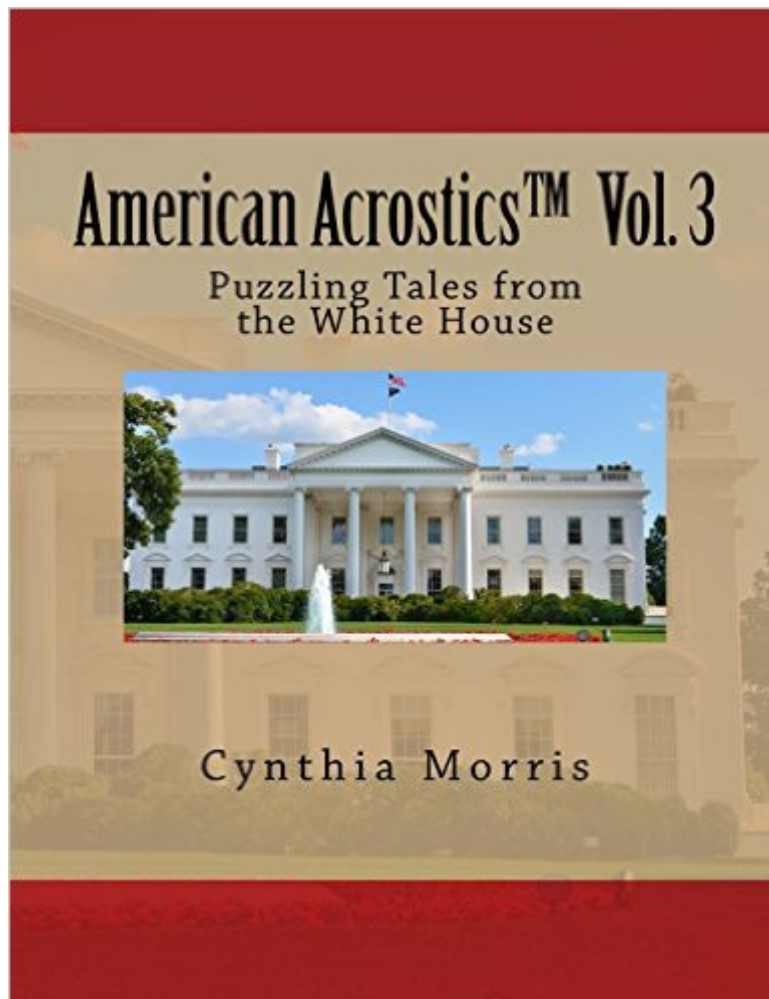

This book includes 50 Acrostics comprised of book quotes about presidents and first ladies. Clues are creative and well-written, with plenty of sneakiness thrown in (Key work = Anthem).
