I was very disappointed by the quality of this book. Given some critical review and editing by both the authors and editors, the next edition of this book could be a very useful primer on homeland security. This current edition, however, was poorly edited, minimal effort (if any) went into source verification, and the authors made judgments/drew conclusions that that were poorly supported at best. Although I am tempted to provide examples of the mistakes, poor documentation, unverified sourcing, and out of date information, I do not wish to publicly embarrass Gaines, Kappeler, or the editors of the book. I do feel compelled to warn students, if required to purchase this book, to read it with a very critical eye. I would also encourage any teachers/professors/instructors to do the same before requiring it for your classes.

The course I took required this textbook. The textbook was very informative. HOWEVER, I've read tens of textbooks relating to criminal justice and this one was probably the driest I've ever had to

read. Retaining the information was difficult because it honest to God is the most boring book I've ever had to lay eyes on.

Copyright is 2012 although not much information on homeland security programs after 2010.
