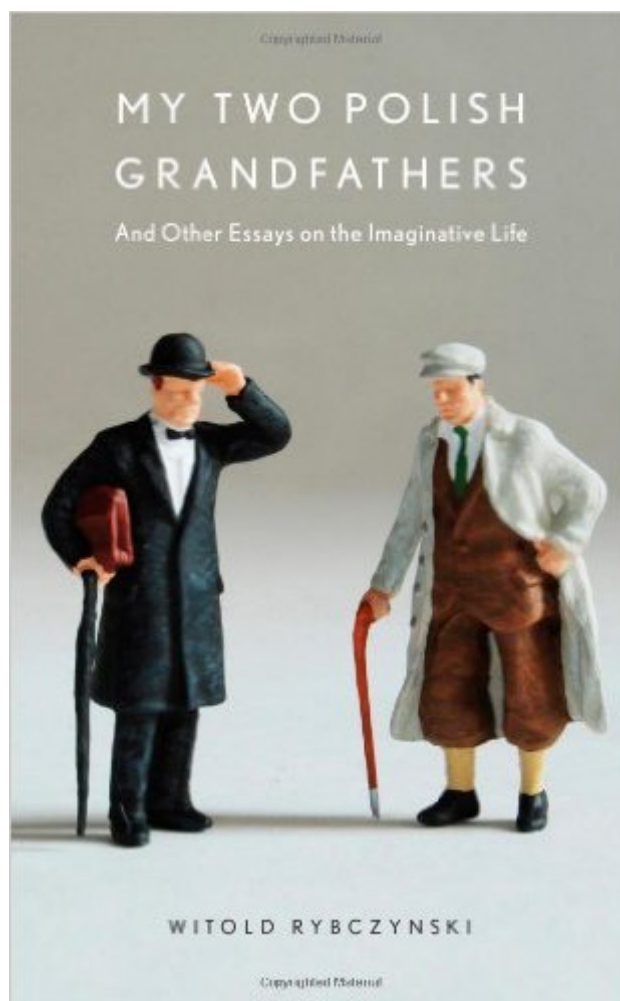

My Two Polish Grandfathers: And Other Essays On The Imaginative Life
