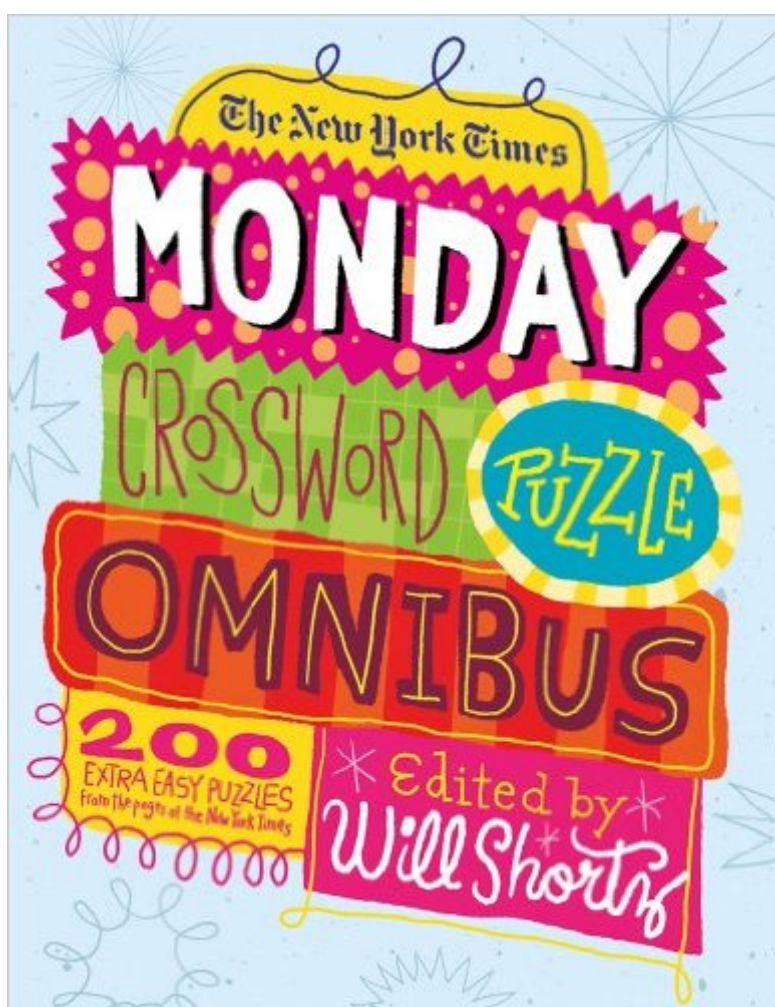

This puzzle book is great for times when you need a little relaxation and don't want to tax your mind too much. They offer a reasonable amount of effort but are not too easy. They do not bore you. Recommended for anyone who loves puzzles.

These quickie-tricky puzzles + warm tea + the glow of a salt lamp are one of my prescriptions to combat insomnia. The clues are smart, twisted and satisfying enough to blow off the steam of the day. You can also get some feedback humor by telling people that you go to bed with Will Shortz or that your evenings include a cunning linguist. (If you understand either of those lame jokes, you should buy this book.)

This is a really nice collection of crossword puzzles. I like the fact that they're easy without being juvenile or schmaltzy. I'm new at crosswords (as a senior citizen) and these are challenging enough

to be fun and solveable. I'm working up to "Tuesday's Puzzles"!!

This is a great collection of Monday crosswords. If you like to do the NYT crosswords and are like me (just not amazing enough to do the Sunday Puzzles) These Monday puzzles are super fun. You can solve many of them without looking anything up which is how I like to do my crosswords and yet they are often tricky enough to make you do some thinking. The size of the book is perfect for me all the boxes are nice and large and there is plenty of space. Definitely not a travel book though. If you are not a master of crosswords this book also has a lot of puzzles that are easy enough that you can learn some of the tricks puzzlers put into their work. Hopefully by the end you will be ready for Tuesdays.

Exactly what I wanted. Years ago I bought an "easy" puzzle book edited by NYT puzzle editor Will Short, and they were so easy I was bored to death. The Monday puzzles in the Times are perfect. I've been waiting for them to publish a collection of them, and here it is. The large format is nice.

These puzzles are just perfect for me. Not so difficult that I give up but not so easy that they're not challenging. I'm going to get the next book of these too. After about the 50th puzzle I started tearing out the page after doing the first side of the page, then turning it over and doing the other side. This way you aren't fussing with the binding. There is plenty of margin on each page that tearing it out doesn't harm any of the puzzle or clues. Great buy, and keeps your mind sharp!

Now that I am retired, I have plenty of time in the morning to do crosswords and enjoy my coffee. I don't get the newspaper everyday, so it's nice to have this book on hand. I have had this book for about 3 week and I've done more that 3/4th of the puzzles in the book. They're very addictive.

I like these puzzles. These are fun, and, as the name implies (Monday series) just challenging enough to keep our interest while maintaining the status of our egos. Those who wish to be humiliated and or need challenges from puzzles with local (New York) references may wish to keep looking.
